All Powerful - Omnipotent.

Whatever He wants will happen, but has chosen to give angels & humans a "free will" to decide their future.

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The Fact - The fact of God's existence is so conspicuous, both through creation and through man's conscience, that the Bible calls the atheist a "fool". Accordingly, the Bible never attempts to prove the existence of God; rather, it assumes His existence from the very beginning. What the Bible does is reveal the nature, character, and work of God.

The Definition - Thinking correctly about God is of utmost importance because a false idea about God is idolatry. In Psalm 50, God reproves the wicked man with this accusation: "You thought I was altogether like you." To start with, a good summary definition of God is, "the Supreme Being; the Creator and Ruler of all that is; the Self-existent One who is perfect in power, goodness, and wisdom."

His Nature - We know certain things to be true of God for one reason: in His mercy He has condescended to reveal some of His qualities to us. God is spirit, by nature intangible. God is One, but He exists as three Persons—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. God is infinite, incomparable, and unchanging. God exists everywhere, knows everything, and has all power and authority.

His Character - Here are some of God's characteristics as revealed in the Bible: God is just, loving, truthful, faithful, long-suffering, righteous and holy. God shows compassion, mercy, and grace. God judges sin, but offers forgiveness to all who repent & follow Him.

His Work - We cannot understand God apart from His works, because what God does flows from who He is. Here is an abbreviated list of God's works, past, present, and future: God created the world; He actively sustains the world; He is executing His eternal plan which involves the redemption of man from the curse of sin and death; He draws people to Christ; He disciplines His children; and He will judge the world.

A Relationship with Him - In the Person of the Son, God became incarnate (a human). The Son of God became the Son of Man and is therefore the "bridge" between God and man. It is only through the Son that we can have forgiveness of sins, reconciliation with God, and eternal salvation. In Jesus Christ "all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form". So, to really know who God is, all we have to do is look at Jesus.

All Present - Omnipresent.

God has always been and always will be. He is the "first cause" & the "conclusion." He is the creator of all things & is outside of time.

Without Sin - Holy.

Almighty God is the one who all other things are measured by. There is no 'evil' in Him & He is bound by His own righteousness & rules.

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Unchanging - Immutable.

"For My thoughts are not your

thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,"

says the Lord. "For as the heavens are

higher than the earth, so are My ways

higher than your ways, and My

Isaiah 55:8-9

thoughts than your thoughts.'

Will not change in His person, purposes, plans & promises. Sometimes He gives people a choice & the outcome is dependent on their response to Him.

All Knowing - Omniscient.

He knows the end from the beginning. Due to "free will," God is allowing the battle with the disobedient angels (led by Lucifer/Satan) to play out through human history. Each individual person must also decide who they will follow.

Spirit in Form - Celestial.

He is not bound by an earthformed body. Jesus took on a
human form only for a short time to
provide redemption of sinners &
satisfy God's justice.

Three in One - Trinity. God the Father, Jesus the Son, the Holy Spirit. Separate yet having the same character, heart & mind as they are One God. As water is a solid, liquid & vapour.
